The "Comité France Amérique" was founded in 1909 by Gabriel Hanotaux, a former Foreign Affairs Minister. His idea of creating an association was triggered by the way the Ministry of Foreign Affairs classified America, which at the beginning of the 20th century was still placed in the "other countries" category. The Committee had a simple but ambitious mission: to alert opinion leaders in the public and private sectors, to America's global importance.

In 1927 the Board acquired a town house, the hotel Le Marois, built in 1863 under Napoleon III in what was then a dynamic new area around the Champs Elysees. Almost a hundred years later, the Association's mission has been broadened, and now it aims to strengthen ties and mutual understanding between France and all the countries of North and South America.
