

## Replicating Viral Vectors for Use in AIDS Vaccines

The International AIDS Vaccine Initiative (IAVI) and the International Association of Biological Standardization (IABS) will co-host a Satellite Meeting entitled “*Replicating Viral Vectors for use in AIDS Vaccines*” prior to the AIDS Vaccine 2009 conference in Paris, France on Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2009. The overall aim of the satellite symposium is to bring together researchers and regulators, discuss progress and problems to date, and engage the regulatory authorities to expedite the development of AIDS vaccine candidates that use replicating viral vectors and smooth the product development process, with a view, if effective, towards eventual licensure of AIDS vaccines. A report of the meeting will be prepared and published in *Biologicals* (IABS journal).
