Conference Highlights

- In 2009, results of the RV144 trial involving more than 16,000 individuals in Thailand were presented, providing the first proof of concept that an AIDS vaccine is possible
- During the Opening Session of AIDS Vaccine 2008, the new South African Minister of Health dramatically discredited 10 years of AIDS policies to mark the official end to the country's denial of HIV as the cause of AIDS
- In 2009, the conference was at full capacity with almost 1200 individuals registered
- 2008 marked the first time the conference was held in Africa, the epicenter of the epidemic
- The AIDS Vaccine 2007 Conference in Seattle, Washington was the first AIDS Vaccine Conference to be organized under the auspices of the Global HIV Vaccine Enterprise
